- Students arriving after 11:30 a.m. will not be processed until 1:00 p.m., as this is the only opportunity for the faculty and staff to break for lunch.

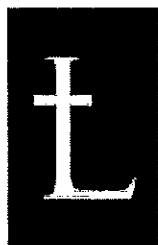

Notes:

- We suggest that only one parent or guardian accompany each returning student. Both parents are welcome to accompany new students. We strongly recommend that younger siblings not accompany students through the line.
- Based on availability, families can park in the school parking lot.

For Welcome to De La Salle Day, please check that your Cavalier meets the following criteria:

- He/she is in “good standing” in regards to financial obligations, including the registration fee, as per the finance office.
- His/her uniform meets all regulations. The dress code information is listed in the Student Handbook.
- Hair and grooming guidelines, as explained in the Student Handbook, have been met.
- Girls’ skirts must be knee-length (all the way around, both front and back).
- Boys must wear ties on this day.
- All students must wear the white uniform shirt. Please do not wear De La Salle sweaters or sweatshirts on this day.
- All students will be checked by the Dean of Students and will be allowed to proceed through the line only after his approval!
